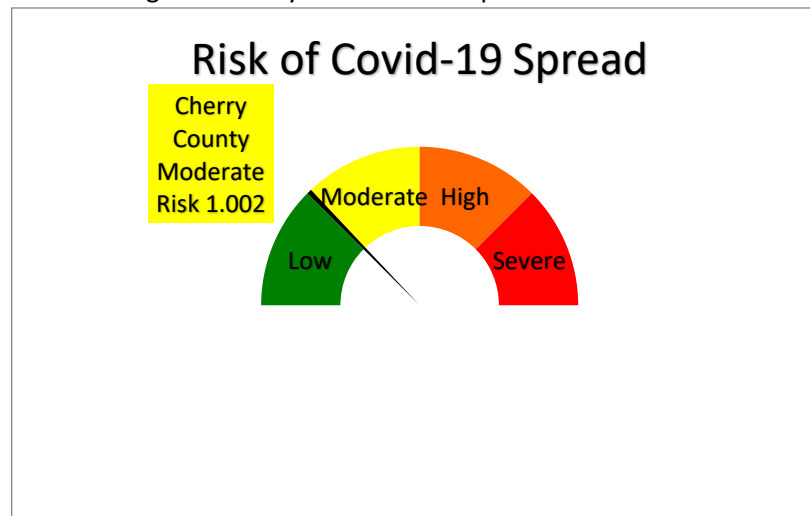


Cody-Kilgore Unified Schools Covid19 Plan

The Cody-Kilgore Unified Schools will use this model to help guide decisions through this pandemic. Our number one goal is to educate our students, but we need to do whatever we can do to keep our community safe. The plan will change based on the NCDHD and the NSAA recommendations throughout the year.

Every week the risk dial will be updated on Monday. As of right now August 3, 2020 we are barely in the yellow. All this means right now is that we increase the amount of cleaning in our buildings. Below lays out what our procedures will be in each risk level.
